Directions

- ❖ CTRF is located at 500 Highway #3 West, Tillsonburg, which is the first building on the north side of Highway #3 to the west of John Pound Road. (This is the old RJR tobacco factory, which is now owned by E&E McLaughlin). When entering the property, take the paved driveway to the left before the main gate. Drive in front of the building and turn to go down the west side of the building. CTRF’s offices are located in Unit #3, which you will see as soon as you turn to go along side of the building. On the wall there is a large “3” where the entrance to CTRF’s offices is located. You may need to park in front of the building since the parking lot can sometimes be full along side of the building.
